2-Year College

Community colleges offer an affordable entry point for U.S. higher education through degree programs in the Associate of Arts or Associate of Science tracks. These 2-year degrees are the 1st and 2nd year of a Bachelor's degree, which prepares students for transfer to our 4-year university partners. The 2-year Associate degree is also a college credential allowing entry for temporary employment in technical, medical and service industries.
